## BSSD Costume Filting Day - March 17

For those of you who are new to BSSD, Costume Fitting Day is typically on a Sunday in March or April and this is where dancers come to try on their costumes that they will be wearing for Picture Day and for their Year End Show Performances

The Day is usually organized by teacher availability but this year will be a little different as our competition team and some teachers will be attending a dance festival the same weekend. If the teacher is not able to attend we will connect with them on the phone or Facetime if they are available. Many of our older dancers classes are impacted by this and will be fit during spring break.

There are a few classes where the costumes have not yet arrived, we will schedule a time to fit them during their regular class times once they arrive, families will be notified via email. Mr. Richard and Mr. Daniel's Hip Hop classes will be fit during regular class time as well and will be notified be email when the date(s) has been determined.

Our amazing Costume Directors, volunteer fitters and sewers will be ready to go to ensure your dancer(s) costume fits properly and they look their best.

On the schedule please check for your dancer(s) time slot by teacher, class and year end show dance name. Note that for some of the Primary classes there are two classes - ensure you are coming for the correct one. If you are unsure you can log in to the parent portal to be reminded which class your child is in.

Reminder to arrive at the time indicated in the Arrival Column. We take the entire class in at once to make adjustments all at once so it's very important to be there on time with your group.

Costume fittings will be done upstairs in the Studios.

When you come upstairs follow the sign to pick up your dancers costume in Studio 1 and take your dancer to Studio 2 for changing. Please note, that there are no "change rooms" so if your dancer is uncomfortable changing in public they can wear a second skin which can be purchased at a dance store, or the parent can bring something to cover them while they change. There will be no males allowed in studio 2, so we have designated 3 separate change rooms for any dads who are with their daugher, and any moms with sons.

If you dancer is in more than one dance, you will need to come back to the Studio for the additional time(s). Unfortunately we will not able to accommodate any changes to the schedule.
