

Kobly & Lutomski Family Achievement Scholarship Criteria – 2023-2024

The annual Kobly and Lutomski Family Achievement Scholarships will be awarded to 2 Beaumont Society School of Dance students who are dedicated to dance and shows continuous effort toward academic success.

CRITERIA

1. Must have completed (with B.S.S.D) a minimum of four years RAD ballet with the lowest eligible class being grade 1 ballet. Primary and Pre-Primary classes are excluded.
2. Must be in grade 8 or higher academically and be achieving academic grade standards.
3. All applications must be submitted by February 20th and include:
 - a) A letter of recommendation from either of the following dated for the current dance season September 2023 and February 2024:
 - Community group (i.e. dance teacher/ member or leader of a community organization at large)
 - Academic recommendation (i.e. school teacher, counselor, principal)
 - b) An essay approximately 500 words in length on a topic selected by the committee each year.
 - c) A copy of the applicant's most recent report card.
 - d) Do not double side print or photocopy any of the documents.

- e) Include a second copy of the documents above with all your personal information (name(s)) removed. You can use a black sharpie to cross out your name, white out your name, or if it is easier – place XXX's in place of your name.

Essay topic for the 2023/2024 Kobly and Lutomski Family Achievement Scholarship is:

How dance has affected my life, the past, the present and the future.

Dancers only need to submit one essay. All submissions will be considered for both Scholarships; however, a dancer may only receive one of the scholarships. Note: If a dancer has been awarded the Kobly Scholarship previously, they will only be considered for the Lutomski Scholarship and vice versa. If a dancer has received both Scholarships, they are no longer eligible for consideration.
